





TOP 10 COUNTRY WISE SRI LANKAN TEA EXPORT QUANTITY (MN KG) JANUARY - 2023 VS 2022





The Western planting districts experienced bright mornings followed by chilly evenings. The Nuwara Eliya's reported sunny weather.

The Uva's reported clear mornings followed by chilly nights. The Udapussellawa's experienced scattered showers.

The Low Grown districts reported sunny mornings followed by occasional evening showers. Showers are to be expected in the Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa districts.

The Western High grown and Uva districts reported a slight increase in their crop intakes whilst the Western medium grown, Low and Udapussellawa regions maintained.

MOMBASA AUCTION OF 13TH/ 14TH & 15TH FEBRUARY 2023

Fair demand for the 236,840 packages (15,917,662.00 kilos) in the market at irregular levels following quality; 32.19% remained unsold.

Egyptian Packers, Afghanistan and Iran showed strong support with Sudan, UK, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries maintaining useful interest. Pakistan Packers, Bazaar, Russia, Kazakhstan and other CIS states showed reduced activity while Local Packers were active in line with price. Somalia maintained interest at the lower end of the market.

BP1: Best - Met irregular enquiry and varied between firm to USC22 dearer to easier by up to USC30 and a select teas shed up to USC61. Brighter - Were mostly firm to USC24 above last prices but some lines lost up to USC10. Mediums - KTDA mediums were irregular ranging between steady to USC12 dearer to USC18 below previous levels while plantation mediums varied between firm to USC12 dearer to easier by up to USC6. Lower Mediums - Were irregular and ranged between USC18 dearer with selected teas gaining USC50 to easier by USC25 with select lines shedding up to USC52. Plainer - Saw irregular activity at firm to USC9 above last rates with selected invoices advancing by up to USC24 to easier by up to USC10.

PF1: Best - Irregular varying between firm to dearer by USC12 to easier by USC9. Brighter - Ranged between USC13 dearer to easier by up to USC10. Mediums - KTDA mediums varied between steady to USC7 above last levels to USC4 below last prices with plantation mediums between USC12 dearer to easier by up to USC6. Lower Mediums - Ranged between USC24 dearer to easier by USC25. Plainer - Were irregular varying between firm to USC20 above last levels to USC18 below previous rates.

PDUST: Best - Ranged between steady to USC15 dearer to easier by up to USC6. Brighter - Were mostly firm at reserve price levels with only a few lines irregular varying between USC2 dearer to easier by up to USC8. Mediums - KTDA mediums were steady at last rates with plantation mediums well competed for advancing by up to USC24. Lower Medium - Saw improved interest and were irregularly dearer by up to USC30. Plainer - Were irregular and ranged between firm to USC43 dearer to USC13 below previous levels.

DUST1: Best - Advanced by up to USC20. Brighter - Were firm at previous prices. Mediums - Most KTDA mediums held value while some lines were neglected but a few selected invoices advanced by up to USC14 with plantation mediums appreciating by up to USC34. Lower Medium - Irregular ranging between firm to USC15 dearer to easier by up to USC16. Plainer - Varied between USC22 dearer to USC12 below last rates.

In the Secondary Catalogues, BPs were firm to dearer while best PFs gained with others steady. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings were irregular while similar DUSTs appreciated. Other Fannings were steady with DUSTs dearer. BMFs were readily absorbed.

BANGLADESH AUCTION OF 13TH FEBRUARY 2023

CTC LEAF: 44,283 packages of Current Season teas on offer once again met with much less demand with heavy withdrawals.

BROKENS: A few clean Brokens on offer met with quite a strong demand and sold at around last levels. All others met with less demand and prices declined quite substantially. Withdrawals were heavier particularly in the plain and poor categories. BLF teas continued to meet with a fairly good demand at around last levels.

FANNINGS: A select few clean Fannings on offer again met with a strong demand and were mostly firm. All other varieties met with less demand and prices declined quite sharply following quality. Withdrawals were again quite heavy particularly for the plain and poor varieties. BLF teas met with a fairly good demand at around last levels.

CTC DUST: 9,829 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fair demand with some withdrawals. Good liquorizing Dusts met with good demand. Mediums met with fair demand and had some withdrawals. Plain and BLF Dusts were again an easier market with some withdrawals. Blenders were fairly active with some interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Offerings again comprised of mostly end of season varieties. Blenders were less active this week whilst Loose tea buyers showed little more interest for the cheaper varieties. Withdrawals were more this week with a further decline in prices. Dusts were an easier market with some withdrawals.

SRI LANKA TEA EXPORTS – JANUARY 2023

Total quantity of tea exported for the month of January 2023 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 17.56 Mn/kg, showing a decrease of -1.83 Mn/kg (-9.42%) compared to the same period in the year 2022. The FOB price per Kg for the month of January 2023 recorded LKR 2,055.34 vis-à-vis LKR 948.24 for the month of January in 2022 (LKR +1,107.09). Total export earnings recorded an increase of +LKR 17.70 Billion (+96.33%) for the month of January 2023 as against the corresponding month in 2022.

Equivalent USD export earnings for the month of January 2023 amounted to approximately USD 99.56 Million as against USD 91.23 Million for the corresponding month last year, which recorded an increase of approximately +USD 8.34 Million.

Country wise analysis of exports shows that Turkey has emerged as the largest export destination from Sri Lanka followed by Iraq, Russia and U.A.E.
