



### COMPOSITION OF ELEVATION WISE ORTHODOX TEA SOLD QUANTITY YTD APRIL – 2023





**Sri Lanka Tea Exports** - Total quantity of tea exported for the month of April 2023 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 16.17 Mn/kg, recording a decline of -2.13 Mn/kg (-11.63%) compared to the same period last year. The FOB price per Kg for the month was LKR 1,856.62 vis-à-vis LKR 1,404.51 (LKR +452.11). Total export earnings recorded an increase of LKR 4.32 billion (16.82%) in 2023 as against the same month last year.

## CROP AND WEATHER (FOR THE PERIOD 08TH – 14TH MAY 2023)

The Western planting districts experienced dull conditions with evening showers whilst Nuwara Eliya's reported sunny mornings followed by overcast conditions. The Department of Meteorology forecasts heavy showers in both regions.

The Uva/Udapussellawa's reported bright weather throughout.

The Low Grown districts reported gloomy conditions with rain. Heavy showers are to be expected in the Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa regions.

The Western's reported a slight decline. The Nuwara Eliya and the Uva/udapussellawa's maintained their crop intakes whilst the Low grown recorded a slight decline.

## MOMBASA AUCTION OF 15TH/ 16TH & 17TH MAY 2023

Fair general demand at irregular levels following quality for the 230,069 packages (15,413,602.00 kilos) on offer; 39.99% were neglected.

Bazaar showed more support with Afghanistan and Egyptian Packers maintaining useful interest. UK were active but selective while Pakistan Packers, Yemen, other Middle Eastern countries, Kazakhstan, other CIS states and Russia showed reduced activity. Sudan and Iran were absent with less enquiry from Local Packers. Somalia maintained activity at the lower end of the market.

**BP1:** Best - Irregular enquiry ranging between steady to USC23 dearer to easier by up to USC40. Brighter - Varied between firm to USC11 above previous levels to USC7 easier and select lines were discounted by USC40. Mediums - KTDA mediums were steady at reserve prices were sold with many lines neglected while plantation mediums shed up to USC27. Lower Mediums - Firm to irregularly easier by up to USC30. Plainer - Were irregular at steady to USC6 dearer for some teas to mostly easier by up to USC12.

**PF1:** Best - Varied between firm to USC8 dearer to easier by a similar margin. Brighter - Were steady to USC5 easier with a few select lines advancing by USC8. Mediums - KTDA mediums were firm to USC12 below previous levels with plantation mediums irregular ranging between USC14 dearer to USC11 below last prices. Lower Mediums - Met irregular interest varying between steady to USC18 dearer to easier by up to USC11. Plainer - Irregular ranging between firm to USC12 above previous rates with select invoices appreciating by USC24 to easier by USC17.

**PDUST:** Best - Ranged between steady to USC15 dearer to easier by up to USC10. Brighter - Met irregular activity at firm to USC7 above previous levels to easier by up to USC12. Mediums - Most KTDA mediums held value with only a few teas irregular varying between USC2 dearer and select invoices advanced by up to USC13 to easier by up to USC8. Plantation mediums were well competed for and appreciated by up USC14. Lower Medium - Gained up to USC14 but a few lines shed up to USC16. Plainer - Saw good but irregular interest with most teas appreciating by up to USC23 while some invoices were easier by up to USC12.

**DUST1:** Best - Most teas advanced by up to USC21 with a few lines easier by up to USC11. Brighter - Were firm to USC7 dearer to easier by up to USC6. Mediums - KTDA mediums were irregular ranging between steady to USC5 dearer to easier by up to USC13 where sold. Plantation mediums varied between firm to USC14 dearer for most lines to easier by up to USC12. Lower Medium - Were irregular ranging between USC19 dearer to easier by up to USC14. Plainer - Firm to USC18 dearer.

**SECONDARY GRADES (S1)** - In the Secondary Catalogues, BPs eased with PFs firm. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings held value while similar DUSTs were discounted. Other Fannings were easier with DUSTs about firm. BMFs were discounted.

## BANGLADESH AUCTION OF 15TH MAY 2023

**CTC LEAF:** 31,592 packages of Current Season & 767 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with less demand at easier rates with more withdrawals.

**BROKENS:** Blackish, well made varieties met with a fairly good demand with prices easing further over last. Medium varieties also met with a fairly good demand and were again easier over last. Plainer varieties eased further and witnessed more withdrawals. BLF teas met with little less interest at slightly easier rates and witnessed more withdrawals.

**FANNINGS:** Best Fannings met with a fairly good demand but prices dropped further upto Tk.10/- and more. Medium varieties met with a fairly good demand but prices eased further by upto Tk.10/- and more. Plainer varieties saw less demand at easier rates and more withdrawals. BLF teas met with little less interest at slightly easier rates and witnessed more withdrawals.

**CTC DUST:** 8,168 packages of Current Season & 167 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with fair demand. Good liquorings sold at easier levels closely following quality. Mediums followed a similar trend. Plain and BLF Dusts were also an easier market and witnessed a drop in price level with fair withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

**COMMENTS:** There was more tea on offer this week which met with a fair interest. With the progress of sale it was evident that demand had slackened and as a result there were higher withdrawals. Blenders lent fairly similar support whilst Loose tea buyers were much less active. Dusts were an easier market. It was noteworthy that quality again showed a gradual decline.

## SRI LANKA TEA EXPORTS – APRIL 2023

Total quantity of tea exported for the month of April 2023 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 16.17 Mn/kg, recording a decline of -2.13 Mn/kg (-11.63%) compared to the same period last year. The FOB price per Kg for the month was LKR 1,856.62 vis-à-vis LKR 1,404.51 (LKR +452.11). Total export earnings recorded an increase of LKR 4.32 billion (16.82%) in 2023 as against the same month last year.

Cumulative exports for the period January to April 2023 including Re-Exports with imported Tea amounted to 70.25 Mn/kg, showing a decline of -11.75 Mn/Kg (-14.32%) compared to last year. The FOB price per Kg for January to April 2023 recorded LKR 1,996.29 vis-à-vis LKR 1,081.05 for the corresponding period in 2022 (LKR +915.24). Total export value for the period under reference showed an increase of LKR 51.60 billion (58.21%) compared to 2022.

Equivalent USD export earnings for the cumulative period January to April 2023 amounted to approximately USD 407.89 million compared with 362.38 million in the same period last year showing an increase of approximately USD 45.51 Million.

Country wise analysis of exports reveals that Turkey has emerged as the largest export destination from Sri Lanka followed by Russia and Iraq.
