





**Sri Lanka Tea Sale Averages for the Month of August 2023** recorded Rs.1,110.54 (USD 3.45) vis-à-vis Rs.1,508.21 (USD 4.18) (-Rs.397.67 in 2022. High Growns for the month of August was Rs.944.14 as against Rs.1,388.26 (-Rs.444.12) in 2022. Medium Growns recorded Rs.953.99 vis-à-vis Rs1,236.14 (-Rs.282.15) in 2022. Low Growns achieved Rs.1,211.48 vis-à-vis Rs.1,616.24 (-Rs.404.76) in 2022.

Cumulative figure for January / August stood at Rs.1,182.03 vis-à-vis Rs.1,137.03 in 2022. High Growns recorded Rs.1,090.60 as against Rs.982.76 in 2022. Medium Grown was Rs.1,018.93 vis-à-vis Rs.946.47 in 2022. Low Growns recorded Rs.1,261.43 vis-à-vis Rs.1,248.08 in 2022. All three elevations recorded an increase during the period of January – August 2023 when compared to the corresponding period of 2022 in the Rupee value. High Grown experienced a rise in the Dollar value, whereas Medium and Low Growns witnessed a marginal decline.

The total CTC average for the month of August 2023 was Rs.892.28. CTC High Growns recorded Rs.860.96; CTC Medium Growns were at Rs.806.82 whilst Low Growns recorded Rs.965.81.

### MOMBASA AUCTION OF 04TH, 05TH & 06TH SEPTEMBER 2023

There was good general demand for the 213,150 packages (14,281,149.00 kilos) on offer with 43.01% neglected.

Kazakhstan and other CIS states lent strong support with more enquiry from Afghanistan. There was maintained interest from Pakistan Packers, Bazaar, UK, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries while Egyptian Packers were active but at lower levels. Russia were less active with Local Packers lending more support. Sudan and Iran were quiet while Somalia maintained activity at the lower end of the market.

**BP1:** Best – Were a strong feature at firm to USC43 dearer and select invoices appreciated by USC60 and USC120. Brighter – Varied between steady to USC48 dearer to easier by up to USC18 and select invoices shed up to USC59. Mediums – KTDA mediums were absorbed at reserve prices while plantation mediums ranged between USC16 dearer to easier by up to USC23 and some teas remained unsold. Lower Medium – Irregular varying between steady to USC36 dearer to USC30 below previous levels. Plainer – Firm to USC26 above last rates to easier by up USC16.

**PF1:** Best – Varied between firm to USC47 dearer to easier by up to USC23. Brighter – Some teas gained by up to USC24 but a number of lines lost up to USC11. Mediums – KTDA mediums were irregular ranging between steady to USC17 dearer for a few lines to mostly easier by up to USC18. Plantation mediums were firm to USC16 below last prices. Lower Medium – Were irregular varying between steady to USC27 dearer to easier by up to USC28. Plainer – Ranged between USC10 dearer to USC11 below last levels.

**PDUST:** Best were irregularly dearer by up to USC32, but some teas shed up to USC13. Brighter – Met irregular interest varying between steady to USC6 dearer to mostly easier by up to USC20. Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm at previous levels with plantation mediums shedding up to USC13 but select lines gained up to USC17. Lower Medium – Varied between steady to USC13 dearer to easier by up to USC22. Plainer – Lost up to USC11 but a few invoices advanced by up to USC6.

**DUST1:** Best – Were steady to USC19 above previous prices with a few lines easier by up to USC20. Brighter – Ranged between mostly steady to USC14 dearer to easier by up to USC12. Mediums – KTDA mediums were firm to USC7 dearer to easier by up to USC16 with plantation mediums steady to easier by up to USC9. Lower Medium – Irregular varying between firm to USC10 dearer to easier by up to USC12. Plainer – Ranged between steady to USC4 dearer to USC16 below previous prices.

**SECONDARY GRADES (S1):** In the Secondary Catalogues, best BPs gained with others steady while PFs appreciated. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings were discounted while similar DUSTs were firm. Other Fannings held value with DUSTs steady. BMFs were well absorbed.

## BANGLADESH AUCTION OF 04TH SEPTEMBER 2023

**CTC LEAF:** 55,409 packages of teas on offer met with less demand at lower rates.

**BROKENES:** All Brokens grades met with less demand and prices declined by a fair margin often by Tk.5/- and more with heavy withdrawals. Plain teas met with a similar trend whereby prices eased further for these varieties. BLF teas met with some support at easier rates with more withdrawals.

**FANNINGS:** Best Fannings met with a fair demand but eased by Tk.3/- to Tk.5/- with some withdrawals. Mediums met with less demand and witnessed a further drop in price and there were heavy withdrawals. Plain varieties met limited demand at lower rates with heavy withdrawals. BLF teas met with some support at easier rates with more withdrawals.

**CTC DUST:** 11,784 packages of teas on offer met with fair demand. Good liquorings Dusts were a fairly good market and were generally firm to a little easier. Others were a fair market but declined in price particularly the plainer Dusts. BLF Dusts met with a limited demand again saw heavy withdrawals. Blenders lent good support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

**COMMENTS:** Large weight of teas were on offer where quality also showed a decline. This met with less interest. Blenders were also less active and operated at lower levels whilst there was some interest from the Loose tea buyers. As a consequence, withdrawals are very heavy surpassing previous record for the season. Dusts were an easier market.
